# BOARD CHAIR LETTER

The Dallas Children's Advocacy Center has successfully completed its 15th year of service to child abuse victims in Dallas County. This year saw two significant changes for the Center, both of which though challenging, had positive results.

The first change was the retirement of the long-time head of the Child Abuse Section of the Dallas Police Department, Lt. Bill Walsh. Bill was the visionary who helped get the Center started, and has been a long-time board member and supporter. While this event could have been considered a loss, we are fortunate that Lt. Ches Williams has proved an excellent addition to our team, and Bill has continued to help produce and grow the annual Crimes Against Children Conference. The Conference saw a significant increase in underwriting this year, notably from two companies who are concerned about the explosion of child abuse via the Internet, Microsoft and Yahoo!.

Our second significant change was the arrival of a new President and CEO, Mr. Lynn Davis. Lynn comes to us from a long and successful tenure at Dallas Challenge, a treatment center for youth alcoholism and drug addiction. Lynn leapt right into the business of DCAC, and turned a fresh eye to how we operate - resulting in a number of changes which will help us do the work we need to do more efficiently.

One of Lynn's most significant initiatives has been to solidify our relationships with each of the 25

police jurisdictions in Dallas County. As a result, we are beginning to see more referrals and will undoubtedly experience a heavier caseload in 2006. We will monitor this increase and determine the best way to serve the additional children and their families.

I would like to express my gratitude to Helen Holman for her leadership as DCAC President and CEO from 2003 through 2005. In addition, my thanks goes to our Vice President of Programs, Larry Robins, who served as Interim President and CEO of DCAC during the months that we were conducting a search.

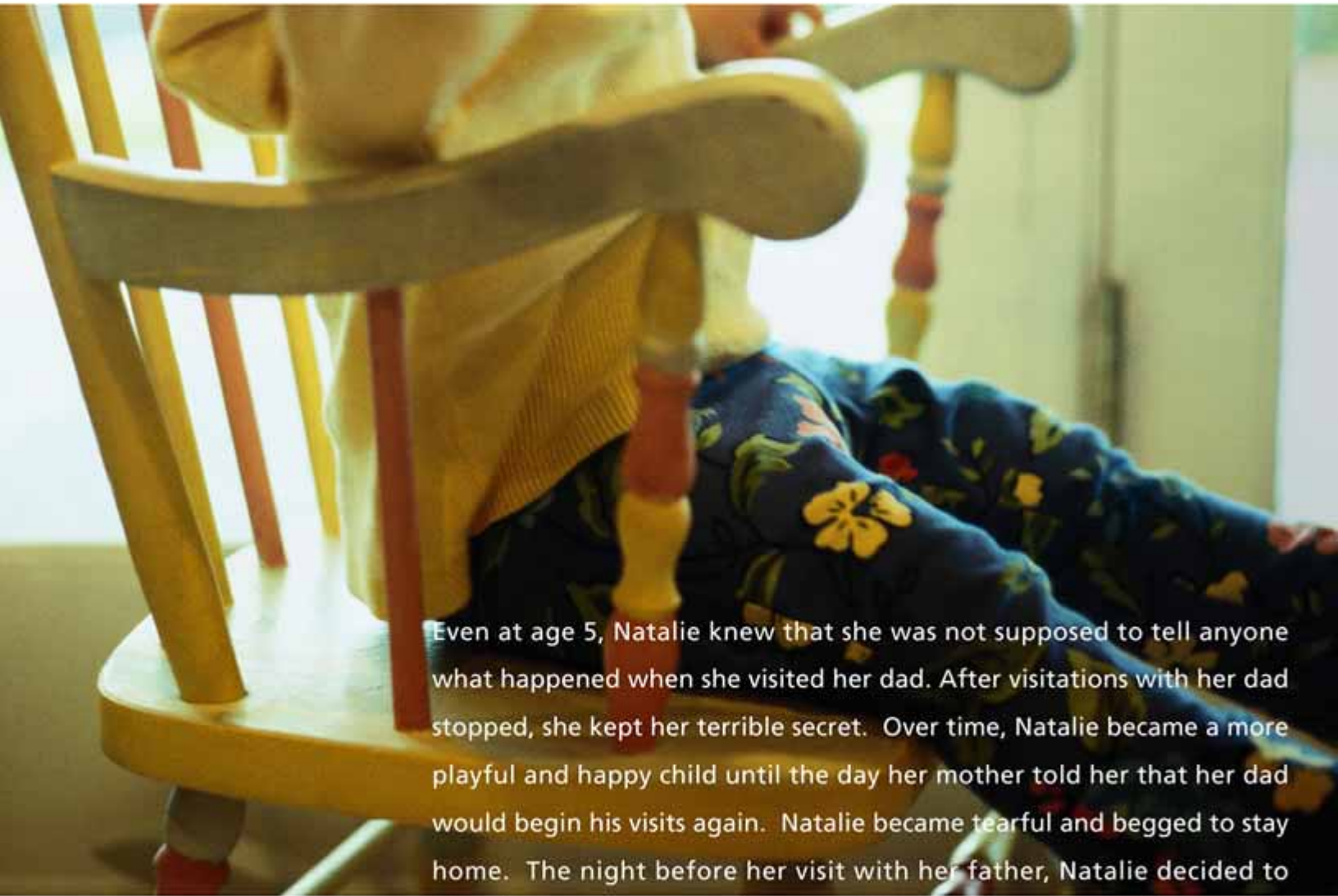

# NATALIE'S STORY

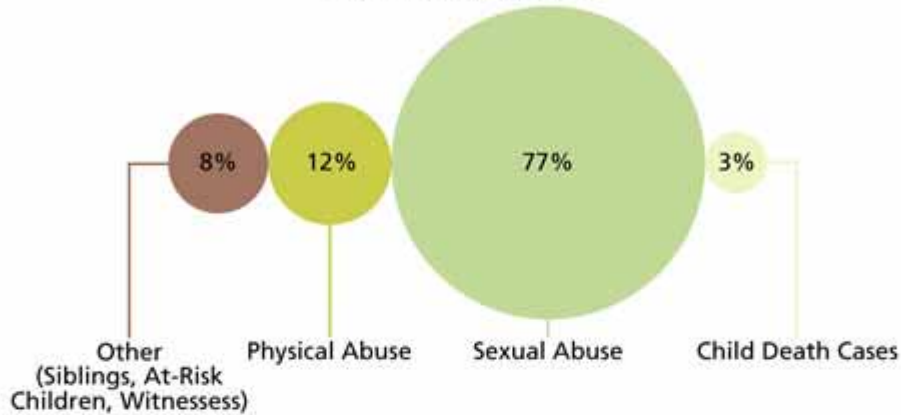


Even at age 5, Natalie knew that she was not supposed to tell anyone what happened when she visited her dad. After visitations with her dad stopped, she kept her terrible secret. Over time, Natalie became a more playful and happy child until the day her mother told her that her dad would begin his visits again. Natalie became tearful and begged to stay home. The night before her visit with her father, Natalie decided to share her secret. She cried as she told her mother what had happened. Natalie was immediately referred to DCAC for a forensic interview but was reluctant to talk about her experience. Eventually, Natalie admitted that her dad would hold a knife to her throat and make her perform oral sex on him, threatening to kill her in her sleep if she told anyone. Since her interview, her visitations stopped, her father was arrested and charged, and Natalie began therapy to begin her recovery.

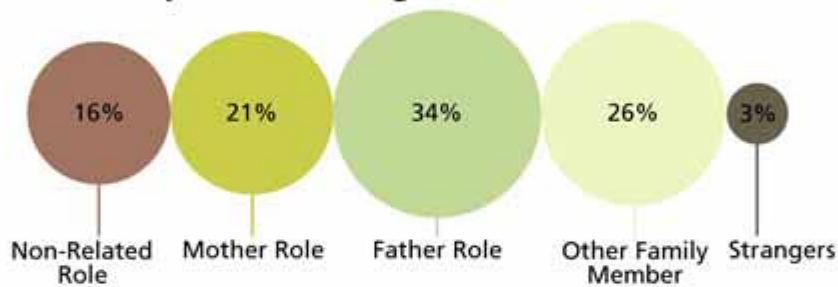

**Service Area: Dallas County - Total Children Served: 1,913**

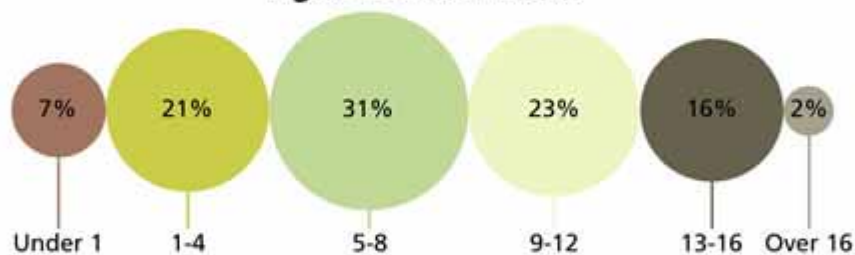
## Primary Allegation



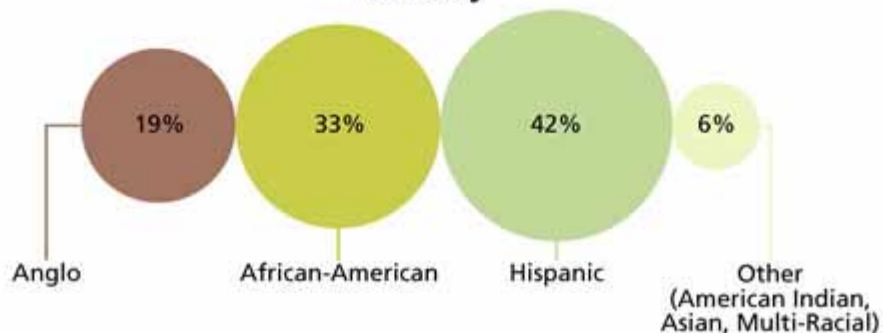
## Relationship Between Alleged Offender and the Victim

# OUR WORK

The Dallas Children's Advocacy Center team located at the Center includes the DCAC staff of child and family therapists, forensic interviewers, victim assistance professionals, administrative staff and volunteers, as well as detectives from the Dallas Police Department Child Abuse Squad, investigators from the Texas Department of Family and Protective Services-Child Protective Services Division (CPS), and a Dallas County Assistant District Attorney. Other professionals on the interagency team include physicians from Children's Medical Center of Dallas and University of Texas Southwestern Medical Center (UTSWMC) Department of Pediatrics and 24 municipal law enforcement agencies from throughout Dallas County. Together, we help children 17 years and younger and their non-offending family members through the investigation, treatment, and prosecution for cases of child abuse and neglect in Dallas County.



## **CHILD ADVOCATE PROGRAM**

The DCAC Child Advocate Program coordinates a cooperative team approach to the investigation and treatment of child abuse cases in Dallas County, greatly enhancing the quality of services provided to child victims.

## **FORENSIC INTERVIEWS**

The interview is the first step in the child's healing and prosecuting the offender. DCAC Forensic Interviewers assist Dallas County law enforcement detectives by conducting investigative interviews of child victims. The interview takes place within the safe, non-threatening environments at DCAC or the Irving Family Advocacy Center. Interview rooms are equipped to allow team representatives to observe the interview, eliminating the child's need to talk about their abuse over and over again. In 2005, DCAC's team of five forensic interviewers conducted 998 interviews of child victims.

## **VICTIM ASSISTANCE**

The DCAC Victim Assistance Coordinator provides crisis intervention and support to child victims and non-offending family members throughout case investigation and prosecution. Information is provided about human services, the rights of crime victims, and Crime Victims Compensation, as well as assistance in completing the application. Clients receive education regarding the purpose of investigation, prosecution and treatment.

## **CASE MONITORING**

Each case is tracked from the initial interview through criminal disposition. To ensure each case proceeds in a way that promotes the well-being of the child, DCAC facilitates weekly interagency case staffing. These weekly meetings bring together CPS investigators, law enforcement officers, prosecutors, medical personnel and DCAC forensic interviewers, therapists and the victim assistance coordinator to review cases and make joint recommendations on how best to proceed.

# OUR WORK

## JUSTICE SERVED

The indictment rate for DCAC cases presented to a grand jury in 2005 was 97%. DCAC cases prosecuted through the Child Abuse Unit of the Dallas County District Attorney's Office recorded a conviction rate of 93%. In addition, 89 juvenile offenders were referred to the juvenile department for criminal prosecution. Sixty percent of convicted adult offenders received prison sentences while the remaining 40% received probated sentences. The average prison sentence was more than 17 years.

## COMMUNITY EDUCATION

Providing quality education on issues of child abuse is a cornerstone of DCAC's mission to break the cycle of abuse. In 2005, we welcomed nearly 2,200 participants from 48 states, the District of Columbia, and several foreign countries, to workshops and lectures at our internationally recognized 17th Annual Crimes Against Children Conference. We provided Recognizing and Reporting Child Abuse training sessions for DART police officers, SMU Guardian Ad Litem students, DISD administrators, child care agencies, school counselors, nurses and teachers as well as community groups from throughout Dallas County. Over 230 UT Southwestern third-year medical and physician assistant students received training on child abuse and the multidisciplinary approach used in the advocacy center model.

## THERAPY

One of the core programs at DCAC is the Therapy Program. It's goal is to help children and their families heal from the trauma of abuse. Each client's treatment is individualized to meet his or her emotional, psychological and developmental needs using a variety of treatment methods, including play, art, individual, family and group therapies. Services are provided to child victims, ages 3 to 17, who were sexually or physically abused, witnesses to violent crime, or children who have lost a family member through homicide. Services are also offered to non-offending caregivers through group and individual therapy. Counseling services are provided at the Center and five satellite locations throughout Dallas County. Since its inception, the Therapy Program has treated 6,320 children and families. In 2005, the DCAC Therapy Program provided 4,808 sessions to 986 clients.

DCAC Therapists also provided 105 hours of expert testimony in the Dallas County court proceedings.

# OUR WORK

## RESEARCH

DCAC is committed to improving our programs through research to collect, analyze, and disseminate information related to our services and other child abuse issues. In 2005, DCAC was awarded a Timberlawn Psychiatric Research Foundation grant to evaluate a pilot parent education intervention program. This program is designed to increase the child therapy participation rate at DCAC by increasing parents' knowledge about therapy and the effects of sexual abuse on children. Another aim of the intervention is to increase parental support, which is vital to abused children's recovery. This study will be completed in 2006.

## DEVELOPMENT

Due to the complicated nature of child sexual abuse, the Center must employ highly trained professionals with abuse specific training and experience to treat these unique cases. The goal of the development office is to raise the Center's operating funds necessary to employ the professionals capable of meeting the needs of these innocent victims. Through the generosity of individuals, organizations, corporations and foundations the Center raises the \$1,127 required to fully treat each child abuse victim. Additionally, the Center and DCAC League produce four fundraising events: Togs and Tots Bingo Luncheon and Mission Impossible in the Fall; and, Racing for Hope and Fun with Foodies and Friends at Central Market in the Spring.

## VOLUNTEERS

The Volunteer Program at DCAC provides diverse, flexible, and meaningful opportunities to those interested in volunteering their time and unique talents toward restoring dignity, hope, and trust to children traumatized by abuse. All volunteers receive comprehensive training. In 2005, more than 450 volunteers and interns, including members of the following volunteer partners provided 13,732 hours of service to DCAC through their generous gifts of time and talent: Assistance League of Dallas, Dallas Junior Forum, DCAC Board of Trustees, DCAC Foundation Board of Directors, DCAC League, Hyatt Regency Dallas at Reunion, Junior League of Dallas and Quilter's Guild of Dallas. Dynamic volunteer opportunities are available throughout the year.

The caring nature and dedication of our volunteers provides DCAC important services that makes a difference in the lives of the children we serve.

## FOR THE YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2005

### DALLAS CHILDREN'S ADVOCACY CENTER

The Dallas Children's Advocacy Center is a unique public/private partnership that brings together several agencies, all of which work to protect children. Since the agency's inception in 1991, DCAC has served more than 20,000 children and families.

Financial support of the Dallas Children's Advocacy Center is used to break the cycle of child abuse and neglect. Approximately 19% of DCAC's funds come from government funding, including reimbursement for counseling services provided to children through our therapy program. Another 25% of our funding comes from our education program, and the remaining 56% of the operating budget is provided through the generosity of private individuals, organizations, corporations and foundations.

DCAC staff has grown from 11 employees in 1991 to 30 employees in 2005, with over 77% of staff providing program services. In the same period, DCAC's operating expense has grown from \$533,000 to \$2,155,000. Program expenses accounted for 78% of the budget in 2005. A unit of the Texas Department of Family and Protective Services – CPS, a member of the Dallas County District Attorney's Office, and the Dallas Police Department Child Abuse Squad are housed at the Center with their respective agencies funding their personnel located on site.

The Dallas Children's Advocacy Center League was created in 1991 to support, serve and promote the mission of Dallas Children's Advocacy Center. The League is not incorporated and, therefore, all activities of the League are consolidated with the Center's activities. In 2005, the League raised 8 % of the Center's total revenue with its two major fundraising events; Togs & Tots Bingo Luncheon and Racing for Hope.

DCAC has established controls and procedures to ensure the long-term financial stability and integrity of the agency. An external independent financial audit is conducted annually to review expenditures incurred and ensure the appropriate utilization of donor contributions.
